







California to Baja California in the south.**




CLIENT SPOTLIGHT: QUEENSCARE



CLIENT SPOTLIGHT: GHANA MINISTRY OF HEALTH

The Odulair mobile clinic trucks travel between the different regions of the country in a convoy, and once on site, they can deliver the services equivalent to those found in a traditional hospital or polyclinic facility.

Govt inaugurates mobile clinics

EIGHT Mobile Specialist Clinics and 10 Biometric Maintenance Vans have been inaugurated.

The clinics, two each for Ear and Nose, Eye, Dental and General Medicine will start operations from next month and will cover all the country.

They will move from one region to the other caring for the sick and will stay at a place for a month or more before moving to another region.

In a speech read on her behalf to launch the mobile clinics, the First Lady, Mrs Lordina Mahama, said that the intention behind incorporating a fully equipped mobile clinics into Ghana's healthcare delivery system was to elevate and advance the capabilities of the existing outreach programme.

She indicated that the vans would take healthcare delivery onto the doorsteps of the people, especially those in the remotest areas.

The First Lady said the mobile clinics formed part of the National Medical Equipment replacement Project, which seeks to replace obsolete equipment at the government hospitals, among others interventions.

She said an important responsibility, which people in positions of national leadership must never lose sight

of, was the empowerment of the most vulnerable of the citizenry, whose daily difficulties and challenges should never be ignored.

Mrs Mahama said "what we become as a nation was dependent upon our capacity to do this".

She said in the unique Ghanaian setting, fellow-feeling, hospitality and care for the extended family make Ghana unique in a world of keen competition and where the poorest in society are exposed to the harsh realities of the times.

According to the First Lady, empowering the poorest in society means creating the necessary environment, circumstances and giving them the opportunity to take hold of their own destiny.

For her part, the Minister of Health, Ms Sherry Ayittey, commended the suppliers Belstar Development Corporation and the manufacturers Odulair LLC, both from the United States, for the detailed planning and modelling of these specialists equipment, which came with their own complete power supply system.

She expressed her appreciation to the US government, the Overseas Private Investment Corporation and the Dueche Bank of New York for the splendid outcome of their partnership with the government for the benefit of Ghanaians.

MOBILE DENTAL Q&A

DO MOBILE CLINICS HAVE TO HAVE A MAILING ADDRESS?

There is no single, direct answer to this. Each state has its policy on mailing addresses for mobile dental. Although in most states, the operator of a mobile dental unit must maintain an official mailing address.



DO YOU HAVE TO BE LICENSED TO DIRECT A MOBILE DENTAL CLINIC?

Each state has its unique requirements and licensing organization. Often the requirements include the mobile dental clinic registering with the state and paying annual fees, providing documented procedures, and including mandatory design features. This may include onboard toilet facility access, a sterilization system, wheelchair access (ramp or lift), and other requirements. In addition, many states require the mobile dental clinic to be owned and operated (in full or majority ownership) by a dentist licensed and in good standing with the applicable state.

HOW MUCH DOES A MOBILE DENTAL CLINIC WEIGH?

Mobile Dental Clinics can vary in weight depending on the vehicle's dimensions and the number of dental operatories. According to Federal standards, for motorized mobile clinic solutions like dental vans or dental trucks, as long as the gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR) is less than 26,000 pounds, you do not need a commercial driver's license (CDL) to operate. Odulair Mobile Dental Clinics are designed with this regulation in mind and are weighed several times during manufacturing to ensure safety standards and federal regulations.

HOW MANY EMPLOYEES DOES A MOBILE DENTAL CLINIC HAVE?

Depending on the size of the unit, a mobile dental clinic van or truck can have as low as one (1) employee, and up to five (5) for something as big as a 30 ft mobile clinic truck model. Common staffing setup for a two (2) operatory mobile dental clinic truck or trailer is a team of 4 people consisting of (1) driver / coordinator, (1) dentists, and (2) hygienists/assistants.
